## **LEAD INSPECTOR TRAINING**

**3 DAYS**

This 24-hour Lead Inspector Initial training course is required by the Ohio Department of Health to apply for a Lead Abatement Inspector license and a ***pre-requisite for the Lead Risk Assessor license***. The purpose of this course is to equip inspectors with the specialized skills necessary to conduct accurate and defensible residential inspections for lead-based paint. Course follows EPA curriculum and HUD guidelines.

**COURSE TOPICS:** History of lead use, sources of environmental lead contamination, development of sampling strategies, lead-based paint sampling and analysis, inspection report generation, testing of other media for lead contamination, Ohio Department of Health rules, EPA/HUD regulations, theory and use of x-ray fluorescence analyzers, disclosure requirements.

**WHO SHOULD ATTEND?:** Housing/commercial bldg. inspectors, industrial hygienists, environmental safety and health consultants, trainers, and community development professionals should attend.

## **LEAD RISK ASSESSOR TRAINING**

**2 DAYS**

This 16-hour Lead Risk Assessor Initial training course is required by the Ohio Department of Health to apply for a Lead Risk Assessor license. ***You must take the 24-hour Inspector Initial to as a prerequisite to apply for the Lead Risk Assessor license.*** Classroom lectures and hands-on activities are conducted to familiarize participants with the likely locations of lead hazards, the interpretation of results of paint, dust, soil and water testing; development of abatement and hazard reduction options; report generation, and disclosure requirements.

**COURSE TOPICS:** Developing testing and sampling strategies, sampling protocols, interpreting testing results, abatement plan development, ODH rules, EPA/HUD regulations.

**WHO SHOULD ATTEND?:** Housing/commercial bldg. inspectors, industrial hygienists, environmental, safety and health consultants, lead program professionals, and community development professionals.

## **LEAD INSPECTOR/RISK ASSESSOR REFRESHER TRAINING**

**1 DAY**

This 8-hour Lead Risk Assessor / Inspector Refresher training course is required by the Ohio Department of Health to reapply for a Lead Risk Assessor or Lead Inspector license. A licensed person must successfully complete the appropriate Ohio-approved refresher course during your two year licensure period. If you do not take a refresher course during that period, you will be charged additional license application fees and eventually you will be required to repeat the initial training course..

**COURSE TOPICS:** Health effects of lead, regulatory updates including ODH rules and EPA/HUD regulations, abatement strategies and controls, and various review exercises.

**WHO SHOULD ATTEND:** Licensed Lead Risk Assessors and Licensed Lead Inspectors
